Established in the year 1964, Kuchinda College has been catering to the higher educational need of not only Kuchinda sub-division, but also the boardering areas of Sambalpur, Jharsuguda, Deogarh and Sundargarh districts. The college has got the distinction of re-accredited by NAAC with 'B' Grade. The vast infrastructure, vibrant campus and learned faculty have added to the quality of education which is reflected from the result of 2017 Annual Higher Secondary Examination as well as University Examinations. The success rate is 94.07% for +2 Science, 74.19%, for +2 Commerce & 76.92% for +2 Arts and 86.61% for +3 Science, 70% for +3 Commerce and 78.76% for +3 Arts. One student namely Mr. Soumya Ranjan Jhankar brought glory to the college by securing 7th position in Physics Honours of Sambalpur University.
