It is my proud privilege to present the Annual Report of Kuchinda College in its 57th Annual Day function today.

Kuchinda college was established in the year 1964 by its founders namely Sri Loknath Panda, the then S.D.O., Kuchinda, Late Gunanidhi Gountia and many others to fulfil the long cherished dream & aspiration of the local people for Higher Education. This college imparts teaching in both +2 & +3 streams to more than 2000 students. Now the college has grown into a Nodal College of Odisha & the second biggest College of Sambalpur district. Although Kuchinda has been identified as an economically back ward area, agriculture being the primary occupation of its people, the percentage of literacy in Sub- Division has gone up from 23% in 1971 to 45% in 1991, In this context Kuchinda College has played an important role over the years & currently it is the first choice among parents & guardians for Higher Education.

Kuchinda College has achieved considerable academic excellence within the framework of an affiliated institution. It has been accredited by the NAAC twice first in 2005 (First non-Govt. College of W.Odisha to be accredited) & then in 2016. Over the years pass out students from this College have occupied important positions in various fields & have brought glory to the Alma Mater. Kuchinda college possess nearly 30,000 books. IGNOU & OSOU study centres are also functioning in Kuchinda college.

In the year 1989 Kuchinda College, Kuchinda celebrated Silver Jubilee & Golden Jubilee in 2015 with much enthusiasm.

For the present generation of youth Covid-19 pandemic is a land mark, a turning point, a transition. It has left a permanent mark on the psychological & academic sphere. In the post pandemic period the "Stress" factor for the youth needs to be addressed. So it is important to make the youth stress free. It is a matter of pride to mention that Kuchinda College has been included under the purview of IDP funded by the World Bank. Presently a new Administrative Building has come up while more class rooms & reading rooms for Library users are under construction. The college possesses a smart hall for seminar & conference which is named as Yuva Sankar Kashya. The Auditorium (WODC) is soon going to function after necessary interior furnishing.
