

HOW TO REACH SAMBALPUR

- Air Connectivity: The nearest airport to Sambalpur is Veer Surendra Sai Airport Jharsuguda (JRG) which is 50.4 km away. Sambalpur's air connectivity is supported by other two major international airports: Swami Vivekananda Airport in Raipur (265 km away) and Biju Patnaik Airport in Bhubaneswar (300 km).


