





1. 3<sup>rd</sup> Phase (if required) will be implemented through 1 Selection admission process. A merit list along with waiting list will be published in respect of each HSS as per their vacancy. HSS may give admission out of the waiting list if vacancies still arises/remain unfilled.



#### Reservation



- > SC-16.25% of the sanctioned strength of each course shall be reserved for SC applicants [6.0. 11710/HE, Dt. 01/06/2015] of each course. (Sample Copy)
- > ST-22.5% of the sanctioned strength of each course shall be reserved for ST applicants [G.O. 11710/HE, Dt. 01/06/2015] of each course. (Sample Copy)
- ➤ PwD-5% of sanctioned seats shall be reserved for PH / OH Students (Extent of handicap not below 40%). The disability certificates shall be issued only through Unique Disability Identity (UDID) card portal website <a href="https://www.swavlambancard.gov.in">https://www.swavlambancard.gov.in</a>. (Sample Copy)
- ➤ ESM/SDP/CoM-1% of the sanctioned seats shall be reserved for Self/Children/Wife/Husband of Ex-Service Man, Serving Defense Personnel & the Children of Martyrs. (Sample Copy)

#### Notes:

- In case there are no applicants in any of the reserved category, the seats will be de-reserved and filled up by the general category applicants at the time of SPOT selection admission.
- > SC/ST applicants selected for admission on merit basis shall not be counted against reserved seats. They shall be treated as general category applicants for admission, but their social category will remain unchanged.

## Weightage



#### 1. NCC

- > Applicants holding 'A' Certificate shall be given weightage of additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the HSC or Equivalents examination.
- Applicants who have represented the State or the Central School/Sainik School at the All India level NCC Camps / Courses / Activities NCC (C) shall be given weightage of additional 3% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the HSC or Equivalents examination. (Sample Copy)

#### 2. Scouts & Guides

- > Scouts and Guides possessing and producing the original certificate signed by the President of India shall be given weightage of additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the HSC/Equivalent examination.
- Scouts and Guides possessing and producing the original certificate signed by the Governor of the State shall be given weightage of additional 2% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the HSC/Equivalent examination.

#### 2. Scouts & Guides

- > Applicants who have represented the country at international level shall be given direct admission.
- > Applicants who have represented the state at **national level** shall be given weightage of additional **10%** of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the HSC/Equivalent examination.
- Applicants who have represented the school at the inter-State School Sports Meet level shall be given weightage of additional 5% of marks over and above the aggregate marks secured at the HSC/Equivalent examination. (Sample Copy)

e-Admission (ON-LINE ADMISSION INTO CLASS-XI) is compulsory for admission into all Higher Secondary Schools affiliated to CHSE (O) including Self Finance, Vocational & Sanskrit Higher Secondary Schools in the State of Odisha for the Academic Session 2022-23. It aims at successful use of Information Technology to make the admission process simple, economical, fast and transparent.



## Timing of Higher Secondary School Admission Process for the AY: 2023-24


The timing of admission process at HSSs will be from 9 AM to 5 PM.





### **Admission Updation & Error Correction Process**






Note: In Error Correction page a logged-in user can make changes of the applicant like:

- d. If the user choose Other option then user can modify the Board Name, Year of Passing, Roll Number of the applicant.


## **Updation of Other Information in HSS Login**






## MIS Reports Generated in HSS Login

## New Proposal: Completion of SPOT Selection Admission through On-line mode

- 1. Candidates who opted for Slide-up request in  $1^{st}$  selection and not selected in the  $1^{st}$  &  $2^{nd}$  round will be considered for SPOT selection.
- 2. Desirous students may be logged in to the student log in created under SAMS to exercise their new preference of choices (not necessarily out of the preferred Higher Secondary Schools at the time of application) in the SPOT selection admission round during the stipulated timeline.
- 3. SPOT Selection merit list will be prepared centrally and Intimation Letter will be generated in the student login. The SPOT Selection merit list also will be available in the respective e-Space.
- 4. Selection information will be shared through **WhatsApp II SMS**.



## Field to Capture the Data of a National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship (NMMS) Awardee









- 1. National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship (NMMS) examination conducted every year to award scholarship to poor meritorious students of Class-VIII of Govt. and Govt. Aided school.
- 2. Selected students get Scholarship @12000/ per annum for four years i.e. from Class-IX to Class-XII to get scholarship money students have to register in Scholarship portal of Ministry of Education Government of India.

#### Process to be follow

- Are you a NMMS Awardee: (Y/N)
- If, Yes: Then NMMS Roll No field must be enable (12 digit / only numeric) (322 \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ \_ \_)
- Here "3" represents the Exam code & "22" represents the State code. It is same for all the Roll Nos.
- Applicants have to fill up only the rest of the 9 digits.
